Media & Communication promoting arts and culture - **publication of newsletters, newspapers,** journals, libraries Visual arts, architecture, sculpture, painting, drawing, photography and film; museums – art, history, science, technology, culture

Performing arts centres and associations – theatre, dance, ballet, opera, orchestras, choral, music ensembles

Historical, literary, and humanistic societies for the preservation of historical and cultural artefacts; commemoration of historical events; promotion and appreciation of the humanities; poetry and literary societies; language associations; war memorials

Advocacy Organizations

Organizations that protect the rights and promote the interests of specific groups – the handicapped, elderly, women, ethnic heritage

Programs and services to promote civil mindedness and human rights; crime prevention and promotion of public safety; victim support and services

Education and Research

Adult/Continuing Education - other than formal educations systems; schools of continuing study & correspondence; literacy and reading programs

Science and Technology - research in physical and life sciences, engineering and technology; social Science and Policy Studies No E&O appetite

Medical Research – specific diseases and disorders No E&O appetite

Social Services

Social, Family; parent education; single parent agencies; family violence/women's shelters & services; social wellbeing of disadvantaged, distressed or vulnerable people

Children, child development centres; licensed infant care and nurseries

Youth - delinquency prevention services, teen pregnancy &, drop-out prevention, youth centres and clubs and job programs

Handicapped - homes other than nursing homes (see Retirement Protect); transportation, recreation and other specialized

Elderly; organizations providing geriatric care; in home services; homemaker services; transport, recreation, meal programs

Family services includes education and support, women's shelters

Self-help and other personal social services; homeless temporary housing/shelter

Organizations providing material assistance - food banks and clothing distribution centres

Environment

Conservation and preservation of natural resources including land, water, energy and plant for the general use and enjoyment of the public, recycling

Environmental beautification – botanical gardens, horticultural societies, organizations promoting the preservation and beautification of green spaces

Programs to preserve parks, green spaces and open spaces in urban and rural areas; botanical and horticultural programs

Recreation and Social Clubs

Provision of recreational facilities & services to individuals & communities – country, leisure, men's & women's clubs

Service Clubs - membership organizations providing services to members and local communities. Lions Club, Kiwanis, Rotary

Community and Social Development Organizations

Community and neighbourhood organizations working to improve the quality of life within communities and neighbourhoods; co-ops; organizations working towards improving the institutional infrastructure and capacity to alleviate social problems and to improve general public well being

Housing Associations

Management and leasing of low income, non-profit housing

Job Training Programs

Organizations providing and supporting apprenticeship programs, internships, on-the-job training and other training programs

Vocational Counseling and Guidance

Vocational training and guidance, career counseling, and related services

Vocational Rehabilitation and Sheltered Workshops

Organizations that promote self-sufficiency and income generation through job training and employment

Business and Professional Associations

Organizations that promote and protect business and professional interest groups; **not regulatory organizations**; organizations promoting, regulating and protecting professional interests

Animal Protection

Animal protection/welfare services, shelters, humane societies; wildlife sanctuaries and refuges including incidental veterinary services

Religion and Associations Congregations

Organizations supporting and promoting religious beliefs and services other than churches
Associations and auxiliaries of religious congregations and organizations supporting and promoting religious beliefs, services and rituals

Philanthropic and Voluntarism Promotion

Grant making Foundations - private, corporate and community Voluntarism promotion and support;
organizations that recruit, train and place volunteers and promote voluntarism
